

Punctuation in the Bertha Language

1. Full Stop (.)

Example: Ami Imam gidi gali mili**.** - RIGHT!!
Ami Imam gidi gali mili - WRONG!!
(My uncle has a black dog.)

2. Question Mark (?)

Example: Ñgo shileya**?** – RIGHT!!
Ñgo shileya – WRONG!!
(Are you tired?)

Ñgo fed'i yaguthá**?** – RIGHT!!
Ñgo fed'i yaguthá – WRONG!!
(Do you like fish?)

3. Exclamation Mark (!)

Example: Álí k'aloqi, "Bik'a agorha**!**" – RIGHT!!
Álí k'aloqi, "Bik'a agorha" – WRONG!!
(Ali said, "Don't cheat!")

4. Capitalization

Used at the beginning of a sentence.

Example: **N**go shileya**?** – RIGHT!!
ngo shileya**?** – WRONG!!
(Are you tired?)

Used for proper names:

Examples: **A**ssosa – RIGHT!!
assosa – WRONG!!

Mohammed – RIGHT!!
mohammed – WRONG!!

mamá – RIGHT!!
Mamá – WRONG!!

gali – RIGHT!!
Gali – WRONG!!

5. Comma (,)

Examples: Gaga galime Álí. – RIGHT!!
Gaga galime Álí. – WRONG!!
(Ali, keep the dog away.)

Álí k'aloqi "Bik'a agorha!" – RIGHT!!
Álí k'aloqi "Bik'a agorha!" – WRONG!!
(Ali said, "Don't cheat!")

6. Hyphen (-)

Used for compound of noun and adjective or verb

Examples: maaba + ágarraña = maabaágarraña - RIGHT!!
(person) (teaching)
[noun] [verb] (teaching person → teacher)
maaba ágarraña – WRONG!!

aagu + k'aas'í = aagúk'aas'í – RIGHT!!
(pumpkin) (small)
[noun] [adjective] (small pumpkin)
aagu k'aas'í – WRONG!!

No hyphen used for compounds of 2 nouns

Examples: shúli + nera = shúlñera – RIGHT!!
(house) (grass) (grass house)
shúlihera – WRONG!!

gaagú + fillí = gaagúfillí – RIGHT!!
(bamboo tree) (root) (bamboo root)
gaagúfiilí – WRONG!!

7. Quotation Marks (" ")

Example: Imam d'ok'otho mama, "Tha kammu shibiloño assahana?" –
RIGHT!!
Imam d'ok'otho mama tha kammu shibiloño assahana? –
WRONG!!
Imam d'ok'otho mama, <<Tha kammu shibiloño assahana?>>-
WRONG!!
(Imam asked my aunt, "How much did the bowl cost?")

8. Word Breaks

A word is not broken at the end of a line.

Gafálé míñ thálé le thá bulú mbá Ímám u Áli u mamá mmaané. Thá gafayú thá bulú afanfé uuthá ful. Ná maadálá Áli gundi thá afanfé gídi ful thá **gafayú**. Ná éndálá Áli ná mufáné afanfé. Ná daané galíeqí, ná fía galiqi. Mín thá gáfú Áli adé thayú thá áné íílá tha babáné Neqémale. Mamá fulá mu thá áné tháma aagu thá mýú. Ná thámané-alú thá duudu lémmín mené. **Badéén** áné líá na-alú thá aagu ilé, indaané Álíé thá áné damá Imámé tha gafue.

- RIGHT!!

Gafálé míñ thálé le thá bulú mbá Ímám u Áli u mamá mmaané. Thá gafayú thá bulú afanfé uuthá ful. Ná maadálá Áli gundi thá afanfé gídi ful thá **ga** **fayú**. Ná éndálá Áli ná mufáné afanfé. Ná daané galíeqí, ná fía galiqi. Mín thá gáfú Áli adé thayú thá áné íílá tha babáné Neqémale. Mamá fulá mu thá áné tháma aagu thá mýú. Ná thámané-alú thá duudu lémmín mené. **Ba** **déen** áné líá na-alú thá aagu ilé, indaané Álíé thá áné damá Imámé tha gafue.

- WRONG!!

9. Affixes (prefixes and suffixes)

Affixes are directly attached to a word, they are not separated by a hyphen.

Examples with Suffixes:

-e

Imame – RIGHT!
(to Imam)

-a

Shogoa? – RIGHT!!
(Is it like this?)

-qi

ahathaqi – RIGHT!!
(he stands)

Imam-e – WRONG!

Shogo-a? – WRONG!!

ahatha-qi - WRONG!!

-lo

niñelo – RIGHT!!
(that woman)

-ne

niñene – RIGHT!!
(this is a woman)

-la

k'alagala – RIGHT!!
(said to him)

nine-lo – WRONG!!

nine-ne – WRONG!!

k'alaga-la – WRONG!!

agurlo – RIGHT!!
(that king)

fiala – RIGHT!!
(he was hit)

agur-lo – WRONG!!

fia-la – WRONG!!

-qa

gadiqa – RIGHT!!
(your child)

-le

giñle – RIGHT!!
(this thing)

gadi-qa – WRONG!!

giñ-le – WRONG!!

Example of Prefix:

a-

aAli – RIGHT!!

(the Ali)

a-Ali – WRONG!!

3. **'Nañ' must be capitalized.**
4. **Question mark is missing from "Nañ s'ulla ñgo?"**
5. **Comma is missing after shiñ.**
6. **'sullane' should not be broken from one line to another.**
7. **'U' should be capitalized (beginning of a sentence).**
8. **Quotation marks are missing from "Waane adiñonne?"**
9. **Quotation marks are " " and not <>.**
10. **'mimba' is not capitalized.**
